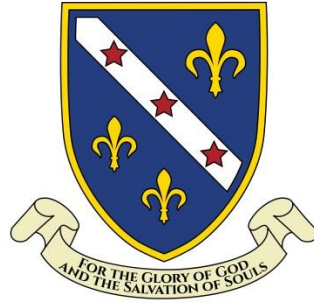

Procedures for Public Masses at St. Cecilia

Archbishop Carlson has extended the dispensation of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass until further notice. Parishioners who are symptomatic or who have been exposed to another with the virus should not come to church, in accordance with national, state and local health directives. We will continue to live stream Masses until the dispensation ends.

- You must be fever free and without sickness to enter the church. Anyone that has been sick in the past two weeks SHOULD NOT come to Mass.
- Everyone must enter through the side door/handicap entrance of the church.
- Doors will open twenty minutes prior to the scheduled Mass time.
- There will be no more than 187 people allowed inside the church. Entrance is first come first serve.
- Masks must be worn waiting to enter church and inside church except while receiving Communion. Hand sanitizer will be available at entrance and exits of the church. Please use accordingly.
- While waiting to enter church six feet distance must be maintained between each family.
- The ushers inside the church will guide you to your seat. PLEASE be respectful and follow their instructions.
- Please remain in your assigned pew throughout Mass. Please only use restroom in case of an emergency.
- Missalettes will not be available. Please bring your own missal with you to Mass if you wish to follow along with the readings.
- Collection boxes will be placed at the exits. Offertory processions are not allowed at this time.
